



Course description and general information

Description:

International degree seeking students and exchange students on behalf of partner universities are going to present their home countries within the scope of so called "Cultural Evenings". Since each student will lay a different focus, we are already looking forward to an exciting course of lectures which will point out the cultural diversity at FH JOANNEUM. After watching the presentations, participants can discuss the findings.

Objectives:

The Cultural Evenings aim to develop the following skills in students: cultural self-awareness, an appreciation of cultural difference, a facility to interpret actions in many ways in order to facilitate cultural understanding, intercultural communication skills and sensitivity for intercultural issues. Moreover, local students gain the possibility to participate in "internationalization at home" and the cultural diversity and heterogeneity at FH JOANNEUM is emphasized.

Scope ECTS: 1

WHO can participate in the course?

All students and staff of FH JOANNEUM can participate in this course.

Registration is just required if they would like to obtain the credits. Participants **register by signing the attendance list (cross at "Cultural Diversity course, 1 ECTS)**.

All students as well as employees are also welcome to join the Cultural Evenings as **guests** (no registration required).

Examination modalities

For the successful completion of the course the following conditions must be fulfilled:

- **Participation** in all Cultural Diversity evenings
- **Proactive participation** during the country presentations and discussions that follow afterwards.







• Submission of **reflection papers** (=assignments) until the next session via MS TEAMS. The assignment questions will be uploaded the following day after each evening - as a task.

No late submissions will be accepted!

Please note:

• **Country presenters** only must hand in **5 out of 6 reflection papers**, as they give a presentation about their own country instead.
