

## Required documents to apply for FH JOANNEUM

- Letter of application (*in English*)
- CV (*in English*)
- Passport copy
- Bachelor certificate \* or Confirmation of the planned Bachelor qualification (*sample form on website*)
- Transcript of Records for verifying compliance with the admission requirements
- Higher Secondary School Certificate (*12th grade, in English*)
- Proof of proficiency in English (*must be provided in the form of a TOEFL Certificate (min. 87 points) or TELC Certificate (B2) or Cambridge Certificate (First Certificate in English, FCE) or IELTS Certificate (5.0) or PTE Academic Certificate (Pearson Test of English; min. 59 points)*)

\* Must be legalised (Apostille) and to be submitted together with a certified English or German translation.

## (Further) required documents by Austrian Embassy

- Passport
- Passport-sized photograph according to the ICAO criteria (size 3.5 x 4.5 cm)
- Admission letter
- Proof of financial means (EUR 672,64 per month)
- Proof of accommodation (for three months)
- Proof of having a health insurance covering all risks
- Birth certificate \*
- Police clearance certificate \*

\* Documents must be legalised (Apostille) and to be submitted together with a certified German translation.
